online retailers). We would recommend getting one in the NIV translation to begin with. It's really help you understand accurate, but also very readable. The great thing is that nowadays you can get every translation you could ever want on your phone by downloading the **YouVersion** Bible app. It also has some brilliant reading plans and notes to help you in the YouVersion on your way! Need more help? Just let us know.

The Bible isn't the kind of book you read from WHERE CAN I GET A BIBLE? cover to cover instead you can dip in and out as you please. Try and set aside 10 minutes each day to read a small portion. Pray before reading and ask God to speak to you. We recommend you start with one of the gospels like the book of Mark. Then maybe read Genesis or some of the Psalms. Reading notes can
